1. Who is it that has the book in his right hand? Verse 1.
2. What are two unique things about this book? Verse 1.
3. What were the requirements for one to open the book? Verse 2.
4. What would be the point of loosing the seals? Verse 2.
5. What three realms contained no man to open the book? Verse 3.
6. Why was no man able to open the book? Verse 3.
7. Did the phrase “to look thereon” mean more than merely viewing the book? Verse 3.

8. How did John respond to the failure to find one worthy to open the seals? Verse 4.

9. Do you think John “wept much” because of self-pity, or because his curiosity would not be satisfied, or some greater reason? Verse 4.

10. What is the significance of these Old Testament Messianic titles? Verse 5. (See Genesis 49:9-10 and Isaiah 11:1-10)

11. When John looked, what did he see instead of a lion? Verse 6.

12. Do you think it was his role as a Lamb that enabled Him or made Him worthy to open the book? Verse 6.

13. What would these symbols suggest about the Lamb: (1) seven horns; (2) seven eyes; (3) seven Spirits? Verse 6.

14. Could a lamb literally take a book out of anyone's hand? Verse 7.

15. What did the living creatures and the four and twenty elders do when the Lamb took the book? Verse 8.

16. We don't have to wonder what the "golden vials full of odors" represent, but what do you think the harps represent? Verse 9.

17. Why do you think the song is described as a "new song"? Verse 9.

18. Why is the Lamb "worthy," according to the song? Verses 9-10.

19. How are the redeemed made "a kingdom and priests" (American Standard Version)? Verses 9-10.

20. Do you think John gives an exact number of angels, or does he suggest an innumerable quantity? Verse 11. (See Hebrews 12:22)

21. How many qualities do the angels ascribe to the Lamb and what does that number suggest? Verse 12.

22. To whom is the universal acclamation and praise of the whole creation directed? Verse 13.

23. What is the only word to be added to what has been said? Verse 14.

24. How would you name the three songs directed to the Lamb?
