1. Who was Tertullus, why was he along, and who was with him? Verse 1.
2. What would we call the things Tertullus said to and about Felix? Verses 2-3.
3. Tertullus implied that he could go on for hours about Felix. Why didn't he? Verse 4.
4. What three charges were brought against Paul? Verses 5-6.
5. What was the false allegation Tertullus made against Lysias? Verse 7.
6. What does Tertullus indicate the Jews would have done if Lysias had not interfered? What really would have happened? Verse 8.

7. How did the Jews violate their own law in Exodus 20:16? Verse 9.

8. How did Paul feel Felix's long experience as a governor would help his case? Verse 10.

9. How does the fact that it had been only twelve days since Paul went up to Jerusalem prove the charge of sedition to be false? Verse 11.

10. What promise of Jesus must have supported Paul when he had no witnesses to do so? Verse 12. (See Luke 21:15)

11. Although Paul truthfully denied stirring up unrest throughout the world, who was actually guilty of it? Verse 13.

12. How does worshipping the same God as always and believing the prophets show that Paul is not the ringleader of a sect? Verse 14.

13. What hope of Paul's preaching is in agreement with the great majority of the Jews? Verse 15.

14. What was Paul's constant aim toward God and men? Verse 16.

15. What are the "alms" and "offerings" mentioned by Paul as he denies profaning the temple? Verse 17.

16. Far from profaning the temple, what did the Jews from Asia find Paul doing? Why weren't the witnesses present? Verses 18-19.

17. Why didn't those present with Ananias testify against Paul? Verse 20.

18. What was the only point of variance between Paul and his accusers - a point on which the Jews do not agree among themselves? Verse 21.

19. What pretext did Felix use for postponing his decision? Verse 22.

20. Although Paul was guarded, what freedom was he allowed? Who lived in Caesarea that could reasonably be expected to visit Paul? Verse 23.

21. What do we know about Drusilla and why did Felix send for Paul? Verse 24.

22. What were the main points of Paul's sermon before Felix and what was Felix's response? Verse 25.

23. What was Felix's real reason for keeping Paul in prison? Verse 26.

24. What was Felix's reason for leaving Paul in prison until Festus took over? Verse 27.
